2018 Fee Structure

Funds raised through school contributions are used to supply educational resources and programs in our school. It cannot be stressed strongly enough that these funds are essential for the school to ensure the resources to provide relevant and quality learning for your child.

The following fee structures are school contributions for student invoices in 2018. The contributions are divided into:

Subject Contributions

- **Mandatory Subject Contribution:** These fees cover the costs of consumables and equipment used for particular subjects.
- **Elective Subject Contributions:** Fees for elective subjects in Year 9 to 12 are **mandatory**. Students and parents should take these fees into consideration when choosing electives e.g. Hospitality, Visual Arts etc.

General Contributions

- **Student Diary:** All students receive a diary.
- **Carnival Levy:** Covers transport where applicable, admission charges and hiring of venues.
- **Student Technology:** Funding is required to provide upgrades and maintenance of the technology infrastructure and to enable us to invest in new technology in the future.
- **P & C Contribution:** These contributions directly enhance and support educational resources for your child and funds are guided by you, the parents and caregivers. P & C contributions are family contributions that are invoiced to the youngest child attending Ku-ring-gai High School. You can be part of future discussions by attending meetings held twice a term.
- **School Contribution:** Are used to purchase educational resources for Key Learning Areas
- **Text Book Bond:** Applicable upon enrolment.
- **Excursions/Incursions:** These are arranged by faculties to support the curriculum and are invoiced as they are organised. Fees for excursions are obligatory for all attending students. As excursion costs are determined on specific student numbers, refund of payments for students who do not attend might not be available and will only be considered once all payments have been processed.

It would be appreciated if all accounts could be paid immediately.
