



LATENESS, UNIFORM, MOBILE PHONE INFRINGEMENT PROCEDURE

What is an infringement?

An infringement is an action by a student that breaches school policies and procedures, for example:

- using a mobile phone in class
- wearing school uniform incorrectly or inappropriately
- unjustified lateness to class/school

What are the consequences of an infringement?

A student who wears the school uniform incorrectly or inappropriately, uses their mobile phone in class or is late to class/school without a valid reason, will be issued with a lunchtime detention supervised by a staff member. If a student receives multiple infringements on the same day. For example, uses mobile phone in class and is in incorrect uniform, there will be separate detentions issued for subsequent days.

What if a student has repeated infringements?

If a student has three infringements per term, then the discipline consequences will escalate including the possibility of a Warning of Suspension or Suspension on the grounds of continued disobedience.

What if a student repeatedly fails to turn up for detention?

If a student repeatedly fails to turn up for detention, then the discipline consequences will escalate including the possibility of a Warning of Suspension or Suspension on the grounds of continued disobedience.
