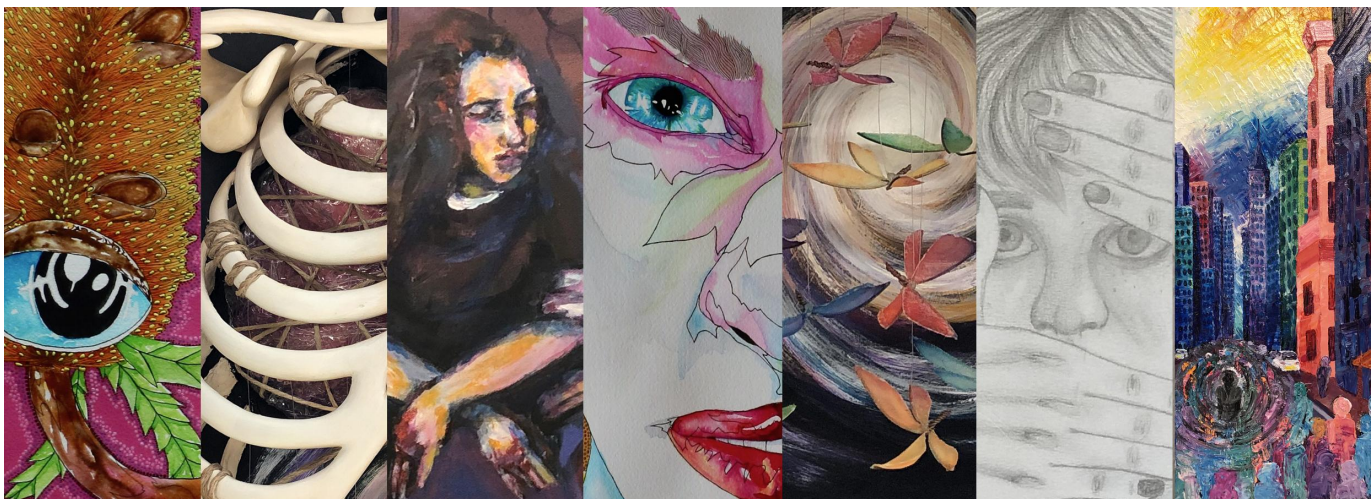

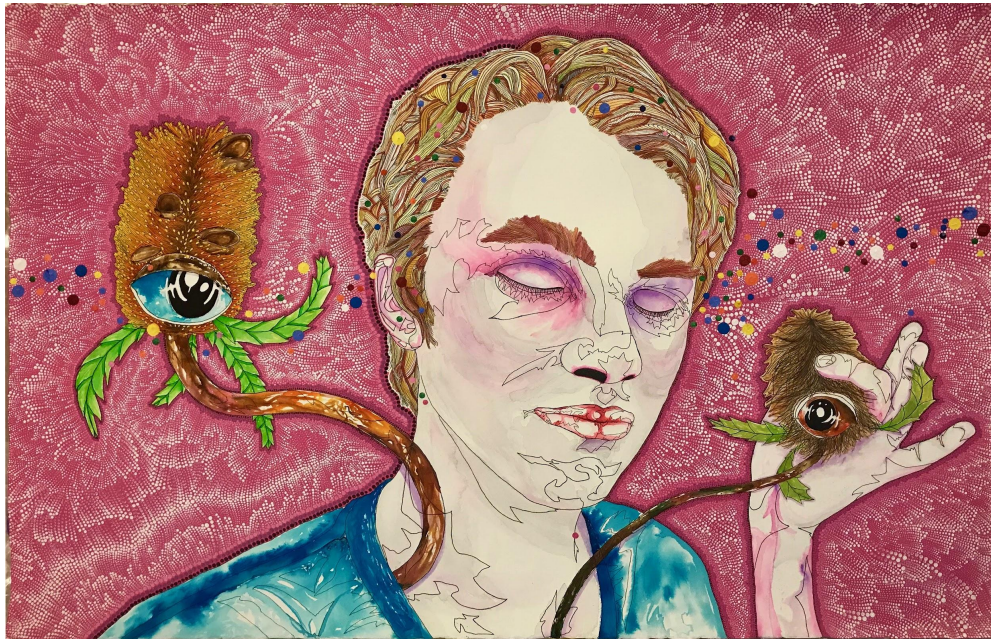

Equipment Requirements

In addition to equipment requirements for Year 7 2022, Northern Academy of the Arts students will require the following equipment for their chosen discipline.

Dance

- gym/swiss ball (45cm if 152 cm or shorter, if taller than 153cm get 55cm size)
- Girls uniform - black tights, black t-shirt
- Boys uniform - black shorts, black t-shirt
- 128 page A4 lined notebook x 2

Drama

- Drama blacks - black pants that are easy to move in, and black t-shirt
- A4 plastic sleeve folder
- 128 page A4 lined notebook

Music

- Instrument or email Carly Rosser to arrange hiring an instrument
- Maintenance equipment specific to your instrument
- A4 plastic sleeve folder
- 128 page A4 lined notebook

Visual Arts

- 60 page A3 Visual arts diary (in addition to the one required for Year 7 Visual Arts)
- Sketching pencils - 6B, 4B, 2B, HB
- Eraser & Sharpener
- Laptop capable of running Adobe Creative Cloud (refer to adobe.com for minimum specifications)
- 16GB USB drive
- 128 page A4 lined notebook
